



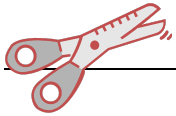
Dear Parents,

Rockwall Independent School District is once again excited to announce that our University Interscholastic League (UIL) will hold a District Meet at the elementary level. Our meet is scheduled for. **Saturday, February 24th at Rockwall Heath High School.** This year's meet will include competitions for second through sixth grade. The events are as follows:

- Story Telling – second and third grade
- Ready Writing – third through sixth grade
- Number Sense – fourth through sixth grade
- Oral Reading – fourth through sixth grade
- Maps, Graphs and Charts – fifth and sixth grade
- Spelling – third through sixth
- Music Memory—third through sixth
- Chess – second through sixth

Students may choose to participate in one of the eight offered events. However, a new exception has been made to UIL. **Ready Writing competition is implemented and completed prior to the district UIL meet on the designated Saturday each year. Therefore, your child is welcome to participate in Ready Writing and one other event if they make the tryouts.** All children who are interested will be given an opportunity to try out after attending practice sessions for the contest. The three highest scores in each contest for each grade level or grade level cluster will be able to compete in the District Meet on **February 24th.** One alternate will also be chosen.
