HOW DOES A STUDENT BECOME ELIGIBLE?

- 1. Does the Student have a (1) physical or mental impairment?
- **■** 2. Does the impairment (2) substantially limit a (3) major life activity?
 - YES for all three (1,2,3) = SECTION 504
 - NO for any of the three ≠ SECTION 504

PHYSICAL IMPAIRMENT

Any psychological disorder or condition, cosmetic disfigurement, or anatomical loss affecting one or more of the following body systems:

- Neurological
- Muscoloskeletal
- Special sense organs
- Cardiovascular
- Reproductive
- Digestive

- Genitourniary
- Hemic
- Lymphatic
- Skin
- Endocrine
- Respiratory


MENTAL IMPAIRMENT

- Organic Brain Syndrome
- Intellectual Disability Emotional or mental illness
 - Specific learning disability (dyslexia)

MAJOR LIFE ACTIVITIES

- Eating
- Breathing
- Concentrating
- Sleeping
- Working
- Walking
- Performing Manual Tasks
- Seeing/
- Communications
- Hearing
- Moving
- And many more!

- Placement Options


