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COURSE OVERVIEW

In this course, students will be using the Read 180 Blended Learning Model. Read 180 Universal features a flexible rotation model designed to help address students at all levels of intervention. This model organizes class time to provide a balance of teacher-lead instruction, scaffold practice, whole and small group interaction.

Rotations will include: Student software application use, independent reading, whole group/small group learning and/or individual student conferences.

Whole Group Learning – Students and teachers engage as a class and reinforce daily lessons together.

Independent Reading – Students have a choice of engaging, content-rich texts to apply newly acquired skills.

Student Application – Students work independently on Read 180 Universal software following a personalized path that accelerates their learning. (90 minutes a week)

Small Group Learning – Students receive targeted, data-driven instruction unique to their individual learning needs.

EXPECTATIONS AND GOALS

- · Come to class prepared to participate.
- · Complete 90 minutes per week on Student Application Software including Fluency recordings.
- · Complete at least 3 story segments in a 9 week period.
- · Complete at least 1 E-Read selection, including graphic organizer, and Quick Write every three weeks.
- · Participate actively in whole group lessons including completing vocabulary and ReaL Book pages.
- · Adhere to all student code of conduct requirements.

COURSE MATERIALS
