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# EVENTS

**The 3-3-3 Stack.** Cups are "up stacked" and "down stacked" from left to right or right to left (individual preference) in three stacks made up of three cups in each stack (3-3-3).

**The 3-6-3 Stack.** Cups are "up stacked" and "down stacked" from left to right or right to left (individual preference) in three stacks made up of three cups on the left, six cups in the center, and three cups on the right (3-6-3).

**The Cycle Stack.** A sequence of stacks combining a 3-6-3 stack, a 6-6 stack, and a 1-10-1 stack, in that order. Stackers conclude the Cycle stack with cups in a 3-6-3 "down stacked"

**Timed 3-6-3 Relay.** This event combines elements of both the "Head-to-Head Relay Competition" and the "Individual Timed Competition". It could be considered an "Individual Relay Team Competition" against the clock (not against another team), and infractions result in "scratches" rather than "penalty points".

# FAQ's

**Do students need their own cups?** No. Speed Stacks will provide a set to borrow for any student who does not have their own cups. However, students are encouraged to bring their own sets if they have them. Additionally, Speed Stacks will have stackmats, sets and other products available for purchase at the event.

**Do student's need experience in stacking to attend?** NO! Students are encouraged to join this recreational competition regardless of stacking abilities or experience. Our staff will be there to assist and help students throughout the event.

**Do students have to compete in all events?** No. Students can participate in all individual events, team events or just certain patterns in which they are more efficient. Students are encouraged to participate with friends or schoolmates in relays. Team relays feature 4 team members.

**What do we do when we get to the event?** Make your way to the registration table. Speed Stacks and Rockwall ISD staff will direct students from there. Announcements will be made before the official start of the event. Students may find a table right away and start warming up upon arrival.

**How many times does a student get to stack?** Students will have sufficient time to warm up in the morning hours and also stack throughout the day. For each event, students will get 2 warm ups and 3 attempts. We'll take the best time of the 3 attempts for each event. This will seed the students amongst other competitors in their age and division.

**How are students grouped?** By grade level then male / female.

**What's the schedule for the event?** Students can start arriving at 8:30 am. We'll give students time from 9:00 - 10:00 am to warm up and practice (students should arrive anytime between 8:30 am - 9:30 am). The competition will officially start at 10:00 am and conclude around 12:30 (ish).
