Dear Choir Students and Parents,

Welcome to 6th Grade Elective Choir! I am thrilled to have you in this ensemble and cannot wait for the beautiful music we will make together! This handbook outlines the ins and outs of choir.

Grading

Students will be given two grades – conduct and content. Conduct is based on behavior during class. Students are expected to be productive in rehearsal while following the rules of the Music Room. Students will be held to 6th grade rehearsal behavior expectations they set for themselves as well. This includes having their Choir folders, all music, and a pencil with them for every rehearsal.

Content will be graded through performances during class and concerts, and also through our work in the classroom. As a Choir, we sing with (but more importantly) FOR each other in a variety of ways – warm-ups, partner singing, part singing, rounds/chants, etc. Throughout the year, we will be learning how to sight-sing (singing solfege patterns without writing the solfege down) and how to read/count rhythms properly.

Concerts and Events

Our 6th Grade Elective Choir are our singing leaders! Because of this, participation in concerts and outings are incredibly important. I like to say 6th Grade might be small in numbers, but mighty in voices! For concerts and performances, 6th Grade will have special parts and/or songs that only they will perform.
