## This Week In Music...

Here, you'll find a brief Lesson Plan describing what we are learning and working on in Music Class this week, complete with the particular Texas Essential Knowledge and Skills (TEKS) taught or reinforced.

## Here's what we're doing the week of August 29th in Music:

Kindergarten - Finishing the "Hello, Everybody!" song/game - adding different families of instruments (TEKS: K.1a, K.1b, K.2a, K.4a, K.4b)

1st Grade - Finishing the "Name, Name, What's Your Name?" song/game - using different families of instruments (TEKS: 1.1a, 1.1b, 1.1c, 1.2a, 1.4a, 1.5a, 1.6a)

2nd Grade - Finishing the "Hey, Children, Who's in Town?" song/game - using different families of instruments (TEKS: 2.1a, 2.1b, 2.2a, 2.4a, 2.5c, 2.6a)

3rd Grade - Finishing the "Jambo!" song/game – adding instruments and special student-created greetings and movements (TEKS: 3.1a, 3.1b, 3.2a, 3.2b, 3.3a, 3.5a, 3.5b)

4th Grade - Finishing the "Oboa Asi Me Nsa (Ghana Stone Passing)" song/game - including studentcreated versions and playing both cooperatively and competitively...we'll also reveal the winner of last week's contest! (TEKS: 4.1a, 4.1b, 4.2a, 4.2b, 4.3b, 4.5a,4.5b)

5th Grade - Finishing the "Just Give Me the Beat!" song/game – we'll reveal the winner of last week's contest, where teams competed in unlocking the eight mystery rhythm patterns from the song! We'll also use xylophones, metallophones, glockenspiels, and Bass Bars! (TEKS: 5.1b, 5.2a, 5.3a, 5.3b, 5.3c, 5.4b)

6th Grade Choir - Continuing to use the "Vocalize!" warm-up book, working on "God Bless America," and start to look at pieces for the Holiday season!!! (TEKS: 6.1a, 6.1b, 6.1c, 6.2a, 6.3a, 6.3c, 6.6a)
