Here's what we're doing the week of September 12th in Music:

Kindergarten - Continuing the "Windy Day" book/song/game - adding instruments (TEKS: K.1a, K.1b, K.2a, K.3b, K.4a, K.4b)

1st Grade - Continuing learning about loud/soft with the "Grizzly Bear" song/game and the "Radetzky March" (TEKS: 1.1a, 1.1b, 1.1c, 1.2a, 1.4a, 1.5a, 1.6a)

2nd Grade - Continuing the "Millions of Cats" book/song/game (TEKS: 2.1a, 2.1b, 2.2a, 2.4a, 2.5c, 2.6a)

3rd Grade – Continuing to learn about Melodic Contour and do-re-mi with the Japanese song "Kuma San" – using a variety of pitched instruments! (TEKS: 3.1a, 3.1b, 3.2a, 3.2b, 3.3a, 3.5a, 3.5b)

4th Grade – We continue working on our PTA Program!!! It will be Thursday, September 29th! We will practice instrument parts for "Oboa Asi Me Nsa," work on "Se, Se, Se," "The Punctuation Song," and learn a brand-new song – "Texas, Our Texas!"

5th Grade – Continue working on composing / playing our own eight-beat rhythm patterns, working with a partner and using instruments that we choose to play our compositions! (5.1b, 5.3a, 5.4b, 5.6a)

6th Grade Choir - Continuing working on our first several songs, including songs for our Holiday Concert and Tour! (TEKS: 6.1a, 6.1b, 6.1c, 6.2a, 6.3a, 6.3c, 6.6a)
