Our high school is overcrowded and we can improve it by creating wider hallways with clear pathways.

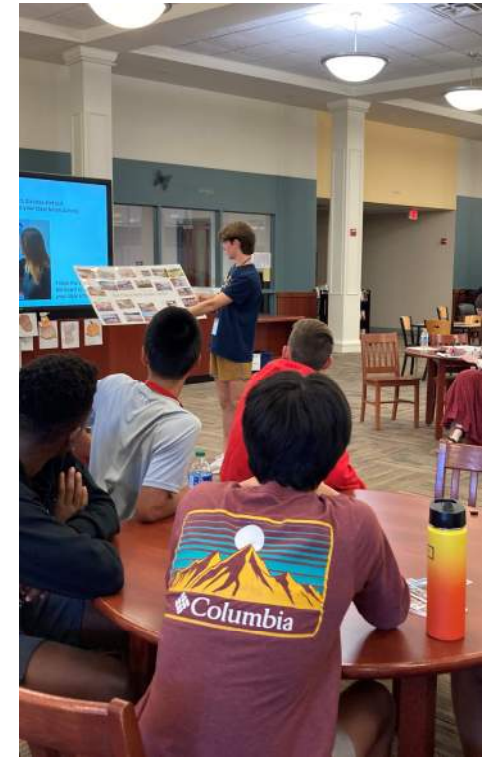
The future Ninth Grade Center will be the place to be if it is a welcoming, fun environment.

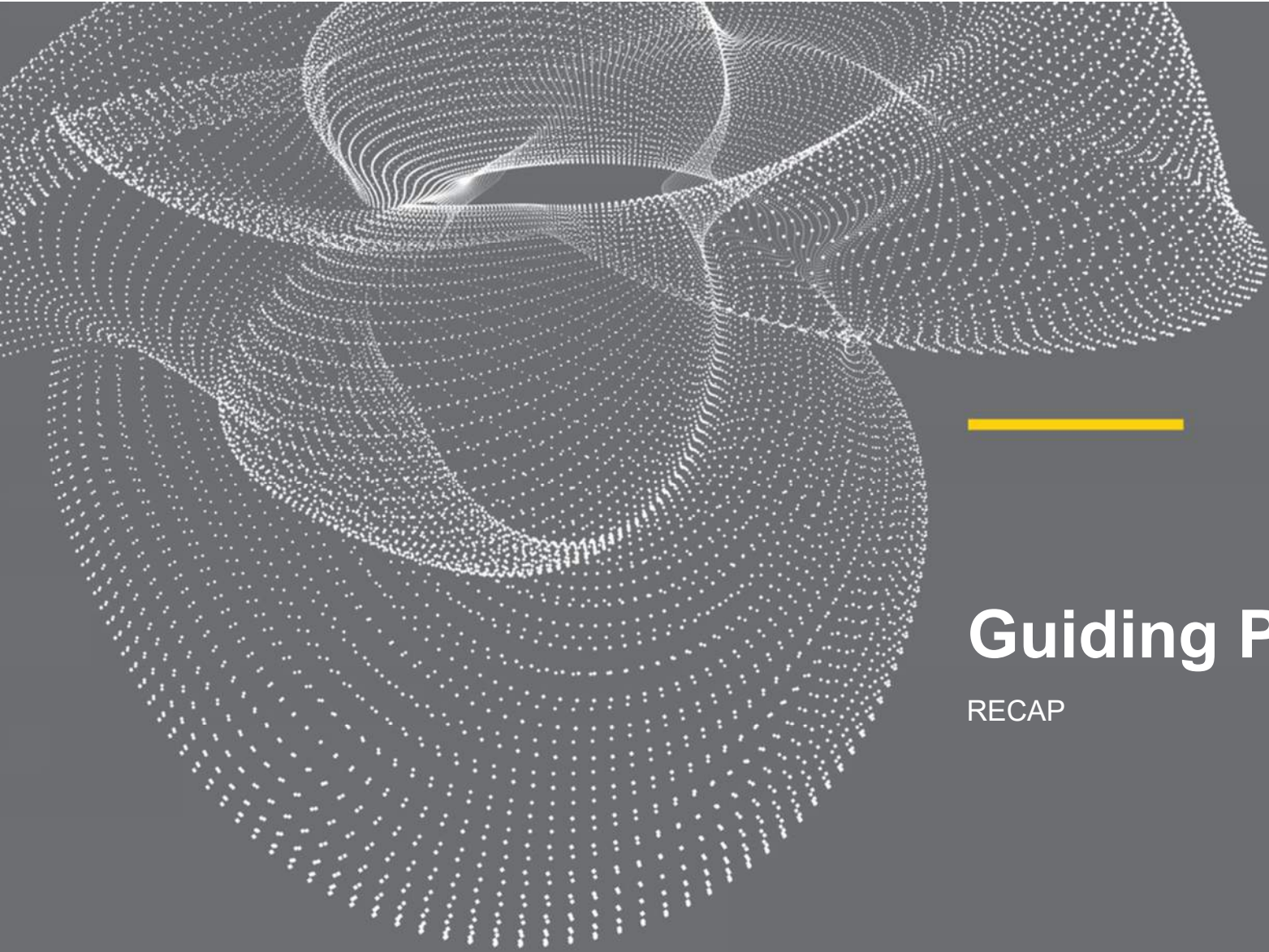

State of the art, future-ready, accessible and flexible for every individual to collaborate and plan for prospective hands-on learning interactions.

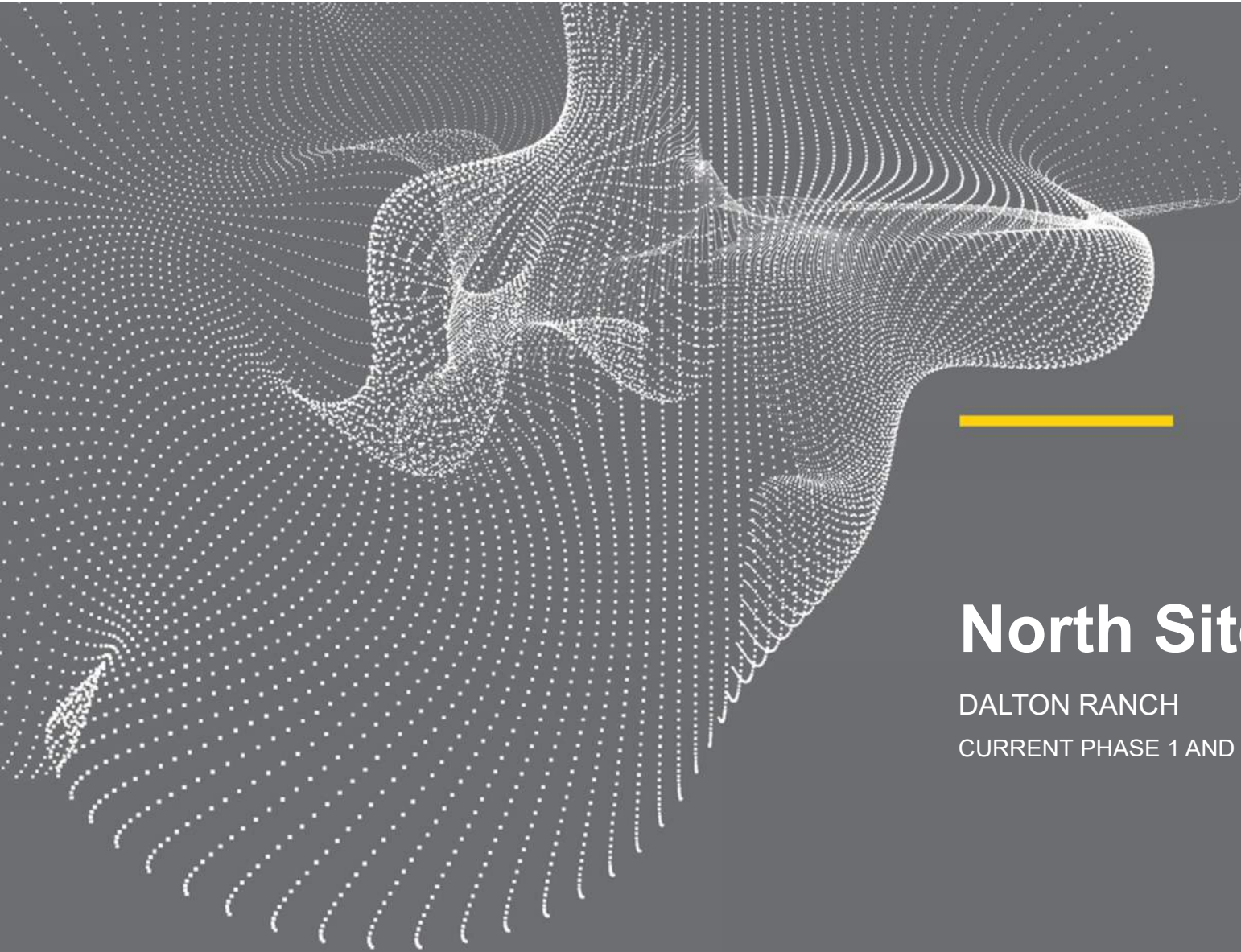

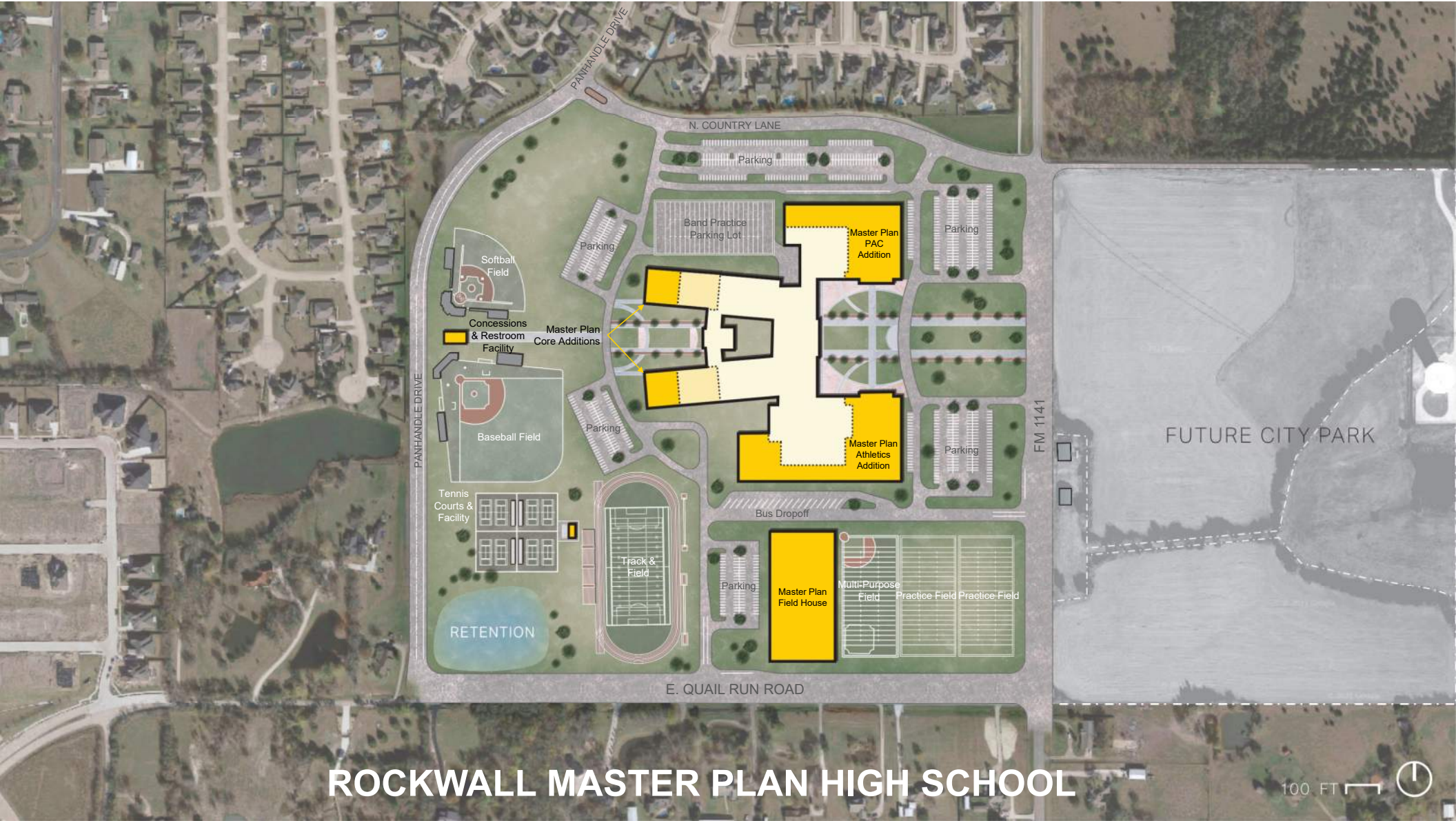

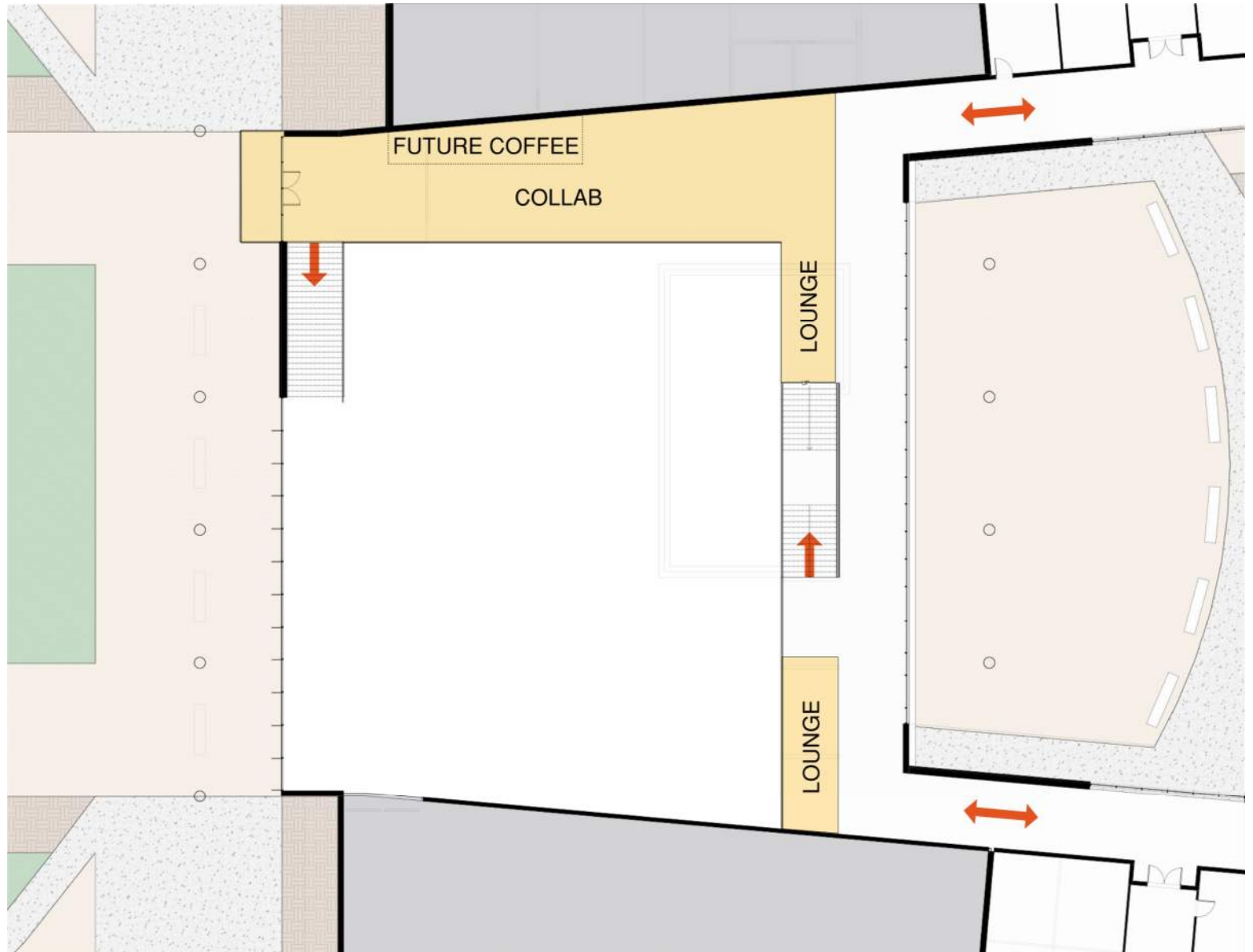
