Common Courses for IB Diploma

English Literature

This is a two ear course which will provide students with skills for literary criticism and analysis, and the ability to clearly express an argument in writing and speaking.

Mathematics Applications & InterpretationORAnalysis & Approaches

This is a two ear course in which students will explore the practical side of mathematical models by describing the real world and solving language Honors is problems using mathematics.

History of the Americas

This is a two ear course based on a multiperspective approach to history. Students will study political, economic, social & cultural history.

French or Spanish

This is a two ear cours which will allow students to acquire an additional language, and to promote an understanding of other cultures through the study equivalanto IB Year 1.

Physics, Biology, or **Environmental Systems & Societies**

These are one or twear course options which will help students understand the natural world, and give them the ability to alter their environments

Visual Arts, Musid-ilm, Social & Cultural Anthropology, or Philosophy

These courses allow students to pursue their varied interests and encourage students to challenge their own creative and cultural expectations and boundaries.



IB Core-required for Diploma

Theory of Knowledge

Students explore the nature of knowledge and connections between areas of shared knowledge and personal knowledge in such a way that students become more aware of their own perspectives.

Extended Essay

Offers the opportunity for students to investigate a topic of special interest in the form of a 4000-word piece of independent research.

Creativity-Activity-Service

Helps students maintain balance and develop their own identities in accordance with the ethical principles embodied in the IB mission statement.



World Class Education

- Internationally recognized diploma will transfer to universities in other countries.
- An IB Diploma guarantest seas 24 credit hours at state universities (Senate bill 111).
- Cost of the IB Diploma is approximately \$800 over the two years of the program (compare with a year of full-time university tuition – national average \$10,423 for in-state residents at public colleges).
- Guarantees multi-disciplinary endorsement, and may supplement other endorsements, as well.



IB Courses

- You may seled Courses stead of the full diploma program
- Most colleges/universities offer credit hours per course, similar to AP.
- You can diversify with IB, AP, and specialized courses at RHS and at GBCCA
- IB Exams are distributed over the duration of the course, and on multiple days in the Spring

For maximum success in the IB Programme we recommend:

- Some AP/Honors/SAGE clasinesh through 10 grades
- Completed Algebra II by end of sophomore year
- Completed Spanish I & II or French I & II by end of sophomo



How is IB different from other programs

- IB students take responsibility for their own learning d understand how knowledge itself is constructed
- IB students are part of cohort of like-minded students and adults who support both academic learning and social-emotional learning
- IB students are part of the larger campus community, and form lasting friendships within their cohort
