

Information Regarding the Grandparent Child Care Affidavit

Rockwall ISD Policy FD(Local) and Texas Education § Code 25.001(b)(9) authorize students cared for after school by their grandparent(s) to enroll in the District using a <u>Grandparent Child Care Affidavit</u>. The information herein sets forth the requirements for this process. <u>Please note, however, that the District has the authority to approve or deny such admissions requests.</u>

For this affidavit, the parent cannot reside in the District, and the grandparent of the student MUST:

- Reside in the District; and
- Provide substantial after-school care for the student in grades PreK 8th.

The parent and grandparent of a nonresident student requesting admission under Texas Education Code § 25.001(b)(9) shall provide to the campus the required information on the grandparent's residency and complete a form provided by the District describing the extent of after-school care to be provided by the grandparent. For the <u>Grandparent Child Care</u> Affidavit:

- A substantial amount of after-school care shall consist of no fewer than three hours of direct after-school care and supervision in the grandparent's home for five days during the regular school week for the student in grades PreK-8th.
- A student enrolled under this provision may continue in enrollment as long as the grandparent provides this level of care; and
- The Superintendent shall have the authority to waive these requirements on the basis of a student's extenuating circumstances.

Each year, a *Grandparent Child Care Affidavit* meeting must be held, at which:

- The parent and grandparent must attend;
- The parent and grandparent will provide proof of residency documentation. (driver's license, a current utility bill, and copy of full lease, if applicable);
- The parent and grandparent will sign a notarized document attesting to the amount of after-school care provided;
- The parent will provide a detailed description of the level of care by the grandparents; and
- The administrator will articulate that approval may be revoked if the student has serious or repetitive discipline or attendance problems after enrollment.
