- 1. SWIM PRACTICE STARTS TUESDAY SEPTEMBER 5!!!7AM-8:30AM. Water polo practice has already started and the weekly practice schedule is being posted on remind.
- 2. Meet and Game Calendar with links to other info— on our website rockwallisd.com. Click athletics, aquatics and RHS Water Polo Swim & Dive.
- 3. Grades make sure your swimmer keeps up on their grades. Grades lower than 70% at the end of the 9 week period will result in them not being able to practice or compete (honors and AP courses are excluded from this rule).
- 4. Parents must pay \$150 per swimmer and water polo player to jacket backers. If you do it online, you can join jacket backers for free. This will give you benefits including eligibility for scholarships.

Swimmers in club swimming will attend 9 practices per week (3 HS and 6 Club). There will be make up practices available. 90% attendance is required for a swimmer to remain in varsity swimming.
- 10. The only overnight meet this season will be State. All others will be daily travel.

## **RISD High School Swimming Contract**

I realize that it is a privilege to participate in athletic activities. Accordingly, I hereby agree to obey the following regulations set up by the UIL and Rockwall Independent School District (RISD).

These rules and regulations shall govern any and all athletes that represent RISD High School in any kind of interscholastic competition. They are designed to promote the ideals of sportsmanship, teamwork, citizenship, responsibility, and pride in representing RISD High School and its community.

- 1. Student athlete's primary responsibility is to academics. To be eligible for any UIL team, you must maintain at least 70% in all classes. No pass/No play.
- 2. All athletes must pass a physical examination and have a copy on file with his/her coach. The athlete and parents must sign the emergency information and the player packet signature form. This form needs to be submitted to the coach before the student is allowed to compete. All RankOne forms must be completed and submitted online; this includes a physical. Forms for the physical are also found online in your RankOne account.
- 3. An athlete may change from one sport to another only if he/she has permission from both coaches.
- 4. Should an athlete be removed from a team by their parents, be dismissed by the coach or quit a team the athlete will not be allowed to attend any further practices or games related to that sports program.
- 5. A legal admit must be presented if the athlete misses any part of school on a game or practice day in order to be considered for participation. Students must attend school.
- 6. An athlete <u>MUST</u> attend practices in order to participate in competitions. At least 90% practice attendance is required to compete.
- 7. An athlete MUST ride on the transportation provided by the school in order to participate in a game being held on that day or a waiver must be submitted prior to the start of the event. Parents must sign form to bring students home from events. Students must stay for the duration of the event.
- 8. A student athlete will immediately become ineligible upon violation of the student code of conduct.
- 9. Show respect for teammates, opponents, officials and coaches.
- 10. 3 tardies is equal to one unexcused absence. Excused absences illness that also keeps student from attending school, making up a test/tutoring or teacher signed note.
- 11. Club swimmers must attend a total of 9 practices per week (3 HS and 6 club) to remain on the varsity team. The athlete is personally responsible for all school athletic equipment checked out, and will return the equipment in good condition and on time.
- 12. To earn a varsity letter, athletes must compete in districts in an individual event.
- 13. Know and follow all state, section and school athletic rules and regulations as they pertain to eligibility and sports participation.
- 14. Win with character, lose with dignity.
